### **Entry Information**

All express mail must be left with <u>no acceptance signature required</u>. Envelopes with more than 10 dogs' entries will be returned. Checks returned for insufficient fees will invalidate the entry; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certifed check, money order, or cash, & received prior to the start of judging.

Entry forms with email addresses will be sent entry receipts, as well as final confirmations, via email. CCC is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Entries without email addresses will receive only final confirmations after closing.

**WAIT LIST:** Cream City Canines will maintain a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries. A maximum of 15 entries per day will be placed on the club's wait list. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

**REFUNDS:** No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil distubances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of the trial committee.

Bitches in season will have entry fees refunded in full. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day.

If you test positive for COVID-19, or become sick or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19, PLEASE withdraw from the trial. Your entry fees will be refunded.

### **General Information**

**DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**: This trial is open to all dogs 6 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number (for mixed breed dogs), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. The Scent Detective Class is open to dogs who have attained any Masters Title within the Odor Search Division.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

**RINGSIDE:** Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the search area when required.

**SAFETY/BEHAVIOR:** The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**COLLARS, LEASHES AND HARNESSES:** During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times. Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

**LIABILITY:** It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Cream City Canines, Sensation Belgians, and their agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children. Cream City Canines reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Cream City Canines, Hawkhill Farm, the AKC, or any official thereof.

**PRIZES AND AWARDS:** Placement ribbons will be awarded to first (Blue), second (Red), third (Yellow) and fourth (White) places. New title rosettes will be offered to any team finishing a title.

### **Site Information**

Saturday's Detective trial is at the Raymond Village Hall. Sunday's trial is at the Raymond School. PLEASE be respectful of the grounds and buildings at both locations!

Exhibitors are expected to keep the grounds clean. You must pick up after your dogs. <u>Anyone witnessed</u> not picking up after his/her dog will be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded.

It is not appropriate to visit the trial locations prior to the trial date. Such visits may risk the club losing the opportunity to use the locations in the future.

Masks will need to be worn only if required by State or County COVID-19 guidelines. Social distancing should be maintained as much as possible.

There will be no indoor crating for exhibitors. All crating to be done in your vehicles. Dogs must be crated or secured in the cars. No ex-pens.

Parking will only be allowed in designated areas. Please do not arrive prior to 7:30 a.m.

No food for exhibitors will be available on the grounds. It is suggested that you bring your own food and beverages.

CHECK-IN & BRIEFING: Check-in and walkthroughs will be discussed in the judging program.

**WARM UP:** Warm up/Recovery boxes will be available. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to one minute or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior to their run, or for recovery after the run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

**SPECTATORS:** No spectators will be allowed at the Saturday trial due to parking space limitations. Spectators are allowed at the Sunday trial as it is at a public park. Spectators may be limited in their ability to view some of the search areas at the discretion of the judge.

**POSSESSION OF ODORS AND TRAINING:** Chapter 5. Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

**SEARCH AREA CONDITIONS:** Searches may be indoors on concrete gravel, or dirt surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces. Search areas may be of any shape, and must be at least 2000 sq ft but no more than 5000 sq ft.
